- School regulation or teacher code prohibits bullying on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity
- See the Hawaii State Board of Education's <u>Student Safety and Welfare Policy 4211</u> (2008).

Idaho

- Law prohibits bullying on the basis of association with someone with a listed characteristic

New York

- Law prohibits bullying on the bases of sexual orientation and gender identity
- See <u>A.B. 3661</u> (2010).

North Carolina

- Law prohibits bullying on the basis of association with someone with a listed characteristic
- See <u>NC General Statutes § 115C-407</u> (2009).

Virginia

• No law protecting LGBT students

Washington

- Law prohibits bullying on the bases of sexual orientation and gender identity
- See <u>RCW 28A.300.285</u> and <u>RCW 9A.36.080</u>, amended to include sexual orientation in 2002 and amended to include gender identity in 2009

West Virginia

• School regulation or teacher code prohibits bullying on the basis of sexual orientation only
