- See Minn. Stat. § 363A.09 (1993).

- Housing non-discrimination law covers sexual orientation and gender identity
- See S.B. 720 (2002) for sexual orientation and S.B. 1047 (2019) for gender identity.
- Prior to 2019, the <u>New York Code of Rules and Regulations §466</u> prohibited gender identity discrimination, via executive order (2015).

- See <u>H.B 2</u> (2016).

- State agency explicitly interprets existing sex protections to include both sexual orientation and gender identity (2018). See Pennsylvania's Human Relations Commission's <u>Guidance on Discrimination on the Basis of Sex Under the Pennsylvania</u> <u>Human Relations Act (PHRA)</u>.

## Rhode Island

- Housing non-discrimination law covers sexual orientation and gender identity.
- See <a href="Rhode Island Stat.">Rhode Island Stat.</a> § 34-37-4, amended in 1995 to include sexual orientation and amended in 2001 to include gender identity.
